OurOptions is a service for adults and promotes independence, informed choice, control and inclusion.



We believe that being independent is important. OurOptions supports you to be more involved in your community.



In OurOptions, you plan what you would like to do and we support you to do this.



We hold an OurOptions' Voice meeting four times a year where you share your ideas about OurOptions.

# Activities



Some of the activities we do in OurOptions include:

- Living skills including cooking and shopping
- Exercise and fitness sessions including swimming and going to the gym
- Trips and days out
- Computer skills
- Activity weekends
- Holiday weekends
- Healthy living sessions

**You can join if you are:**

- Referred by a Social Worker or receive a Direct Payment or Personal Budget
- Between 18 and 55
- Live with sensory, learning or physical disabilities
- Are able to manage your own personal care needs
- Are able to take your own medication
